#### Activity 2

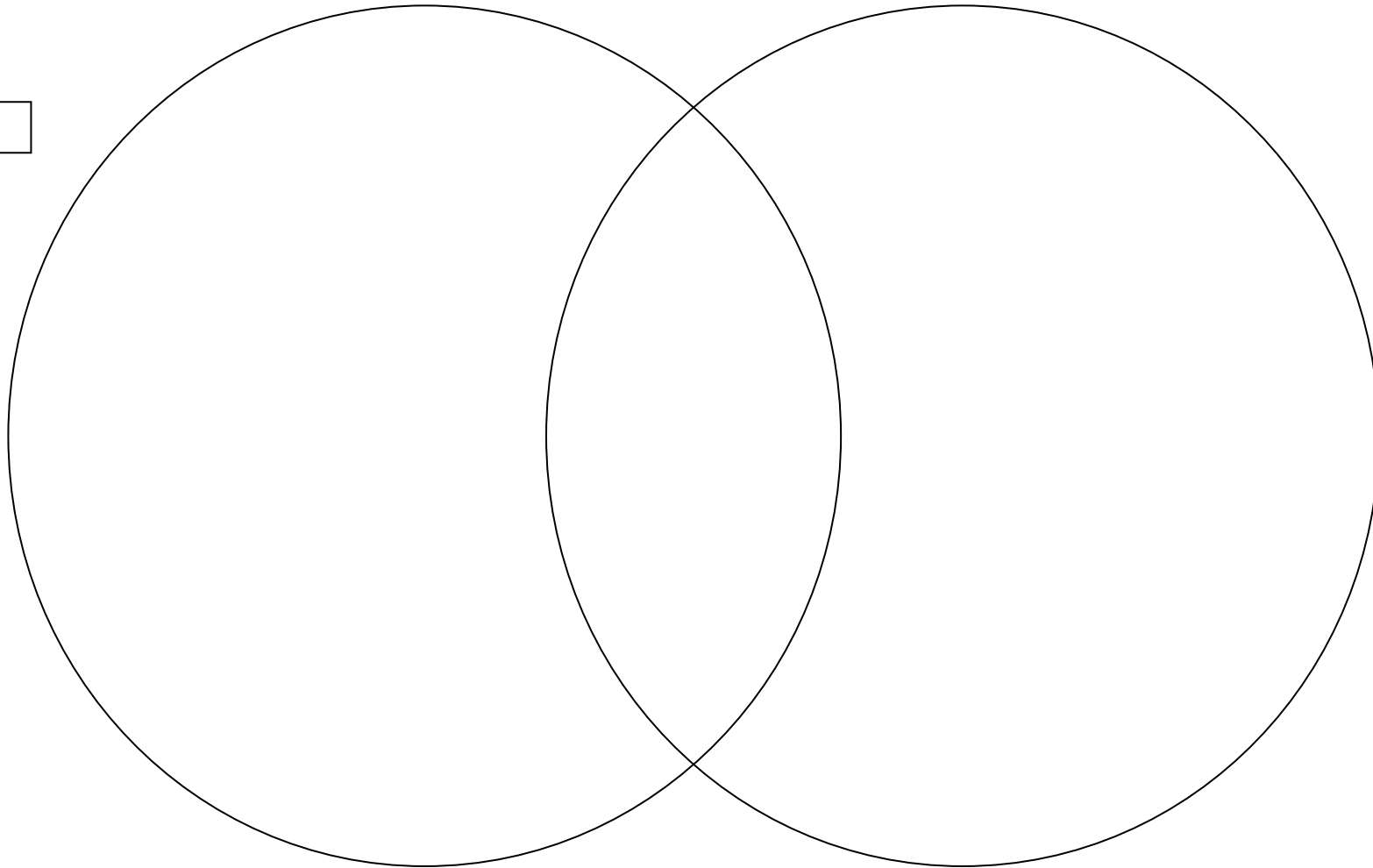
